Ask about the doctor's office policies and how they would handle:

Transportation assistance:

Will the doctor's office help coordinate transportation to and from your appointment?

Labs and tests:

Can you get your labs and other tests in the doctor's office, or do you have to go to another location?

Same-day appointments:

If you have an urgent need, can you get a same-day appointment?



Hospital care:

If you need surgery or emergency care, will your doctor care for you in the hospital?
